NOTICE OF ELECTION, OFFICES ON BALLOT, AND FILING DEADLINES**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN TO ALL QUALIFIED PERSONS that a consolidated Statewide Primary Election will be held on **Tuesday, June 8, 2010**. The following judicial, county and district offices are up for election in Marin County:

Qualifications for office: Member of the State Bar or judge of a court of record in CA for the preceding 10 years

COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

District 1	4 years
District 5	4 years

Qualifications for office: registered voter of the district which he/she seeks to represent for at least 30 days immediately preceding the deadline for filing nomination documents for the office of supervisor. Shall reside in the district during his/her incumbency.

**ASSESSOR-RECORDER-
COUNTY CLERK**

4 years

Qualifications for office: must be a registered voter of the county at the time nomination papers are issued; and hold a valid appraiser's certificate or a temporary appraiser's certificate issued by the State Board of Equalization. Does not apply to any person holding the office of assessor on January 1, 1997.

DISTRICT ATTORNEY

4 years

Must be a registered voter of the county at the time that nomination papers are issued and admitted to practice in the Supreme Court of the State.

SHERIFF-CORONER

4 years

Qualifications for office: must be a registered voter of the county at the time that nomination papers are issued and meet the professional qualifications required by Govt. Code Section 24001, 24004.3 and 830.1 and 830.2 of the Penal Code.

**COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT
OF SCHOOLS**

4 years

Qualifications for Office: Must be a registered voter in the district and possess a valid certification document authorizing administrative services.

DISTRICTS

	4 years	2 years
Almonte Sanitary District	2 seats	1 seat
Ross Valley Sanitary District (#1)	3 seats	

Qualifications for office: must be a registered voter of the district. Additional qualifications are determined by the Principal Act of the District.

CITIES/TOWNS

City of Belvedere and the Town of Ross. Contact the city clerks of the respective cities for forms and filing information.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that signature in lieu of filing fee petitions may be obtained and filed in the Registrar of Voters' Office from January 4-February 10 for judicial candidates and from January 4 to February 25 for all other candidates required to pay a filing fee;

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Declaration of Intention period for **judicial candidates only** is from February 1 to February 10;

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the official Declaration of Candidacy forms for eligible candidates desiring to file for judicial, county and district elective offices must be obtained from the Office of the Registrar of Voters, Room 121, Marin Civic Center, San Rafael, California, between February 16 to March 12, 2010. Declaration of Candidacy forms shall be accepted for filing with the Registrar of Voters between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. and until 5:00 p.m. March 12, 2010. In the event that an incumbent officeholder does not file for his/her office by March 12, 2010 the filing period will be extended for non-incumbent candidates for that office only until 5:00 p.m. March 17;

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that in the event there are no nominees or an insufficient number of nominees for any district office and a petition signed by 10 percent of the voters (or 50 voters, whichever is less) of the District requesting an election be held is not presented to the office of the Registrar of Voters, an appointment to the elective office will be made by the Board of Supervisors;

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 8, 2010;

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to California Elections Code Section 15060 et. seq., al 12107 et. Seq., all ballots cast in the Primary Election shall be counted at the individual precincts;

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN THAT PURSUANT TO California Elections Code Section 15004 et. Seq., the first day to vote and the first day for the Registrar of Voters to mail vote-by-mail ballots for the Primary Election is May 10 at the Marin Civic Center, 3501 Civic Center Drive, Room 121, San Rafael, California.
